At Cane Break Gun Club, safety is always our top priority. To ensure our members and guest remain safe and have an enjoyable experience, we've outlined our Gun Range Rules, the 4 Gun Safety Rules, and Gun Range Requirements.

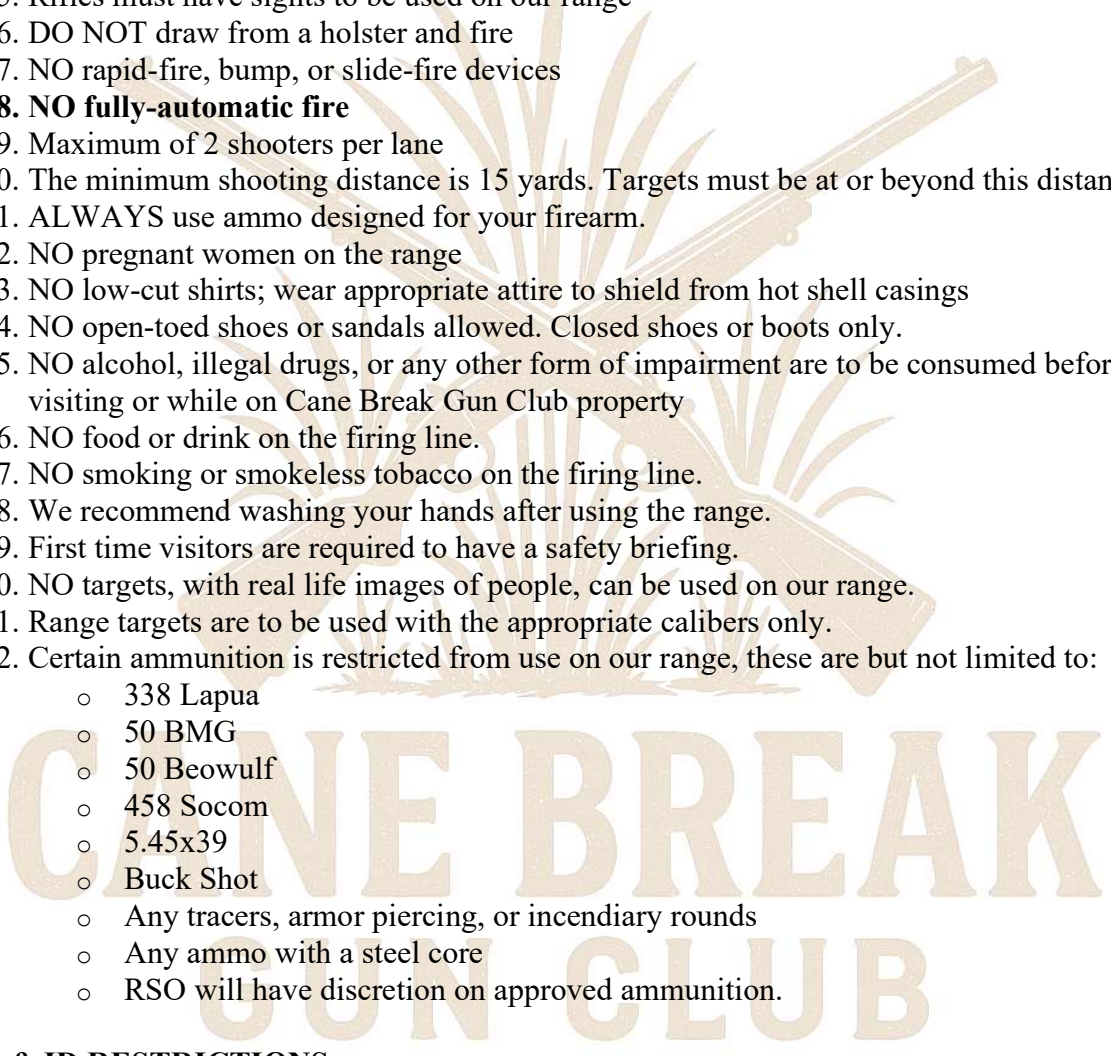
Range Safety Officers (RSO): Enforce all gun range rules, can provide assistance if needed, and have final say over all personnel on the range.

4 GUN SAFETY RULES

1. ALWAYS treat your firearm as if it is loaded
2. ALWAYS point your firearm down range
3. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
4. ALWAYS be aware of your target and what is beyond it

GUN RANGE REQUIREMENTS

1. Shooters and visitors must check in at Range Office
2. ALWAYS wear eye and ear protection
3. NO uncased firearms outside of your shooting lane. Must be a secured case, zippered or clasp/lock. Plastic Bags (Clear or Not) are unacceptable.
4. ALWAYS keep the action open and firearm unloaded until ready to fire. Consider every firearm as "loaded" and treat it as such.
5. DO NOT load ammo outside of your lane
6. NEVER cross the firing line for any reason. Do not attempt to retrieve anything that falls in front of the firing line. If you lose a piece of equipment, ask the RSO for assistance.
7. Upon the command "CEASE FIRE", stop all shooting immediately, put down your firearm and back away from the firing line. Do NOT re-approach the firing line or pick up your firearm until the "All Clear" signal is given.
8. DO NOT shoot the floor, ceiling, walls, or any range equipment; all rounds must impact the back stop
9. Pregnant women are not allowed near the firing lines and must stay in observation areas only due to the potential of lead exposure.
10. If you observe any unsafe behavior or condition by anyone, everyone is expected to call a CEASE FIRE and report it to a Range Safety Officer immediately

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11. If a cease fire is called, unload your firearm with the cylinder open, or slides locked back, and step back from the shooting position.
12. Emergency 'cease-fire' applies to all bays and is in effect until an RSO declares the range is " hot "
13. Individuals in the bay must declare the range is safe " COLD " before ANYONE goes forward of the red safety line
14. If you brought more than one firearm, we recommend that you use only one at a time. This will reduce the chance of loading the wrong ammunition.
15. Rifles must have sights to be used on our range
16. DO NOT draw from a holster and fire
17. NO rapid-fire, bump, or slide-fire devices
- 18. NO fully-automatic fire**
19. Maximum of 2 shooters per lane
20. The minimum shooting distance is 15 yards. Targets must be at or beyond this distance.
21. ALWAYS use ammo designed for your firearm.
22. NO pregnant women on the range
23. NO low-cut shirts; wear appropriate attire to shield from hot shell casings
24. NO open-toed shoes or sandals allowed. Closed shoes or boots only.
25. NO alcohol, illegal drugs, or any other form of impairment are to be consumed before visiting or while on Cane Break Gun Club property
26. NO food or drink on the firing line.
27. NO smoking or smokeless tobacco on the firing line.
28. We recommend washing your hands after using the range.
29. First time visitors are required to have a safety briefing.
30. NO targets, with real life images of people, can be used on our range.
31. Range targets are to be used with the appropriate calibers only.
32. Certain ammunition is restricted from use on our range, these are but not limited to:
- 338 Lapua
 - 50 BMG
 - 50 Beowulf
 - 458 Socom
 - 5.45x39
 - Buck Shot
 - Any tracers, armor piercing, or incendiary rounds
 - Any ammo with a steel core
 - RSO will have discretion on approved ammunition.

AGE & ID RESTRICTIONS

1. Must be 18 or older to use the range unaccompanied
2. Minors (under 18 years old) can shoot but must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
3. All shooters above 18 must possess a valid state-issued ID or US passport
4. Must be 21 or older to possess a handgun
5. Must be 18 or older to possess a long-gun

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

- Shooters are required and expected to clean up after themselves. All spent brass should be picked up and disposed of in designated receptacles.
- General trash should be deposited into provided bins.
- All Range targets are to be picked up and stored in proper area after use.

Act responsibly at all times. Foul language, horseplay or any other unsafe activity will not be tolerated. If we observe an unsafe act we will help you understand what you did and work with you to learn the correct safety procedures. If you repeat or commit another unsafe act, you may be asked to leave the range and meet with the Chief RSO. If you appear to be impaired (such as under the influence of alcohol or drugs, including prescription medication), you will be evaluated by the RSO; you may be asked to leave the range. The safety of everyone is a primary goal of Cane Break Gun Club. We want you to enjoy shooting and will work with anyone who wants the same.

IN ALL CASES THE RSO'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL AND BINDING. HIS/HER DECISIONS ARE BASED ON THE CURRENT SITUATION AS IT EXISTS, AND HIS/HER JUDGEMENT DICTATES. THE RSO'S DECISIONS MAY SUPERSEDE THE GENERAL PRINTED RULES.

Cane Break Gun Club reserves the right to refuse use of the range or service to any person for any reason.
